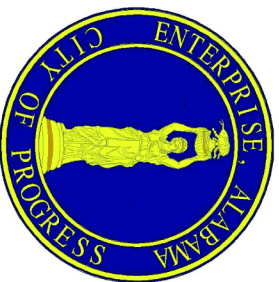

Frequently Asked Questions....

Guidelines

The City of Enterprise will soon start the Automated Garbage Collection Program in your area. This brochure contains helpful information that will acquaint you with the City's Automated Collection Program. The City is committed to provide its citizens with the best possible garbage collection service.

Your current City issued garbage collection containers will be used in this program. Each container is numbered and assigned to a specific address. You **MAY NOT** use any other container for garbage, except the city issued container. The container is the property of the city. If you move please leave the container at the residence.

Placement of the container is the MOST IMPORTANT aspect of the program!

- A **white flag** will be placed at your residence indicating the proper placement of the container.
- The container must have at least a 4 foot clearance from **mailboxes, cars, trees, power poles** or **any other obstacle**.
- Please **DO NOT** place containers under low hanging trees, or wires, as a 15 foot overhead clearance is required.
- Place the container with the handle facing away from the curb.

Q. Is my garbage collection day changing?

N0. Your garbage collection day will be the same. Please have your container placed by 7:00 AM the day of collection.

Q. May I use another container?

N0. Only the 90 gallon, city issued, container may be used.

Q. What kind of refuse may I put in the container?

Typical household garbage may be deposited in the container. In the interest of cleanliness, we encourage you to use plastic bags for wet garbage, and to occasionally rinse out your container per city ordinance.

Q. What is not allowed in containers?

No building debris, flammables, paint, concrete, oil, grease, hot coals, rocks, dirt, or other garden debris.

Q. What are my options for garbage that will not fit in the container?

If your garbage consistently exceeds your container's capacity, you will need to purchase an additional container. Placing anything on top of container will result in container **NOT** being serviced. Call 334-348-2665 for additional information.

Remember

- ALL garbage **MUST** be inside container.
- The handle **MUST** be facing away from the street.
